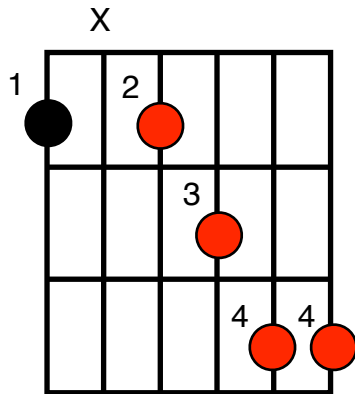

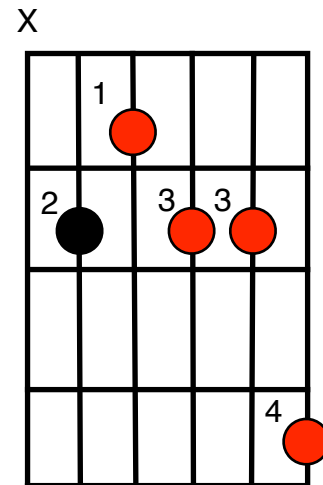
Root Note E String

The chords above are dominant 13 chords, normally written with just the number 13 after the chord letter name, D13, E13 etc. The root note of the chord is shown by the black dot on both the E and A strings. The table below shows the names of the notes at each fret on both the E and A strings.

The chord spelling of a dominant 13 chord is:- 1 3 5 b7 9 11 13
