The chord spelling of a minor 11 chord is:- $\begin{array}{lllllll}1 & \text { b3 } & 5 & \text { b7 } & 9 & 11\end{array}$

In some American publications the minor 11 chord is shown with a minus sign between the chord letter name and the 11:-C-11.
